How this document came about.

The scripture says that God is in us. The Apostle John noted the God and man union in Jesus' quotes. Later, Apostle Paul was given the primary message of the Godhead indwelling man.

God in man is demonstrated in the following combinations.

Father and Jesus Christ in you:

John 14:23 Jesus answered and said to him, If a man loves Me, he will keep My words: and My Father will love him, and We will come to him, and live with him.

2 John 1:9 Whoever transgresses, and does not remain in the doctrine of Christ, does not have God. He who remains in the doctrine of Christ has both the Father and the Son.

Jesus Christ/Spirit of Christ (Rom 8:9) in you

John 6:56 He who eats My flesh, and drinks My blood, dwells in Me, and I in him.

John 14:20 At that day you shall know that I am in my Father, and you in Me, and I in you.

John 15:4-5 (4) Remain in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it remains in the vine; neither can you, unless you remain in Me. (5) I am the vine, you are the branches: he who remains in Me, and I in him, the same bears much fruit: for without Me you can do nothing.

John 17:23 <u>I in them</u>, and You in Me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that You have sent Me, and have loved them, as You have loved Me.

John 17:26 And I have declared to them Your name, and will declare it: that the love by which You have loved Me may be in them, and <u>I in them</u>.

Rom 8:9 But you are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if the Spirit of God dwells in you. Now if any man does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Him.

1 Cor 6:17 But he who is joined to the Lord is one spirit with Him.

- 2 Cor 4:7 But we have this <u>treasure in earthen vessels</u>, that the excellence of the power may be of God, and not of us.
- 2 Cor 4:10 Always bearing about in the body the dying of the Lord Jesus, that <u>His life</u> might be made <u>manifest in our body</u>.
- 2 Cor 4:11 For we who live are always delivered to death for Jesus' sake, that the <u>life</u> also <u>of</u> <u>Jesus</u> might be made <u>manifest in our mortal flesh</u>.
- 2 Cor 13:3 Since you seek proof of <u>Christ speaking in me</u>, Who is not weak towards you, but is mighty in you.
- 2 Cor 13:5 Examine yourselves, whether you are in the faith; prove your own selves. Do you not know that <u>Jesus Christ is in you</u>, unless you are reprobates?
- Gal 1:15-16 (15) But when <u>it pleased God</u>, who separated me from my mother's womb, and called me by His grace, (16) <u>To reveal His Son in me</u>, that I might preach him among the heathen; I did not immediately confer with flesh and blood:
- Gal 2:20 I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; no, it is not I, but <u>Christ lives in me</u>: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the Son of God's faith, Who loved me, and gave Himself for me.
- Gal 4:6 And because you are sons, <u>God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into your hearts</u>, crying, Abba, Father.
- Gal 4:19 My little children, of whom I travail in birth again until Christ is formed in you,
- Eph 3:17 That <u>Christ</u> may <u>dwell in your hearts</u> by faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love.
- Eph 3:19 And to know the love of Christ, which passes knowledge, that <u>you</u> might be <u>filled with</u> <u>all the fullness of God</u>.
- Phi 1:20 According to my earnest expectation and my hope, that in nothing I shall be ashamed, but that with all boldness, as always, so now also <u>Christ shall be magnified in my body</u>, whether it be by life, or by death.
- Col 1:27 To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is <u>Christ in you, the hope of glory</u>:
- Rev 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hears My voice, and opens the door, I will come in and will dine with him, and he with Me.

Holy Spirit in you

John 14:17 Even the Spirit of truth; Whom the world cannot receive, because it does not see Him, neither knows Him: but you know Him; for He dwells with you, and shall be in you.

2 Tim 1:14 By the Holy Spirit Who dwells in us, keep that good and beautiful treasure which was committed to you.

Spirit of God in you

Rom 8:9 But you are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if the Spirit of God dwells in you. Now if any man does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Him.

1 Cor 3:16 Do you not know that you are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?

His Spirit in you

Rom 8:11 And if the <u>Spirit of Him</u> Who raised up Jesus from the dead <u>dwells in you</u>, He Who raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by <u>His Spirit</u> Who <u>dwells in you</u>.

God in you:

- 1 Cor 14:25 And thus are the secrets of his heart expressed; and so falling down on his face he will worship God, and report that God is truly in you.
- 2 Cor 6:16 And what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For you are the temple of the living God; as <u>God has said</u>, <u>I will dwell in them</u>, and <u>walk in them</u>; and <u>I</u> will be their God, and they shall be My people.
- Phi 2:13 For it is <u>God</u> Who <u>works in you</u> both to will and to do of His good pleasure.
- 1 John 3:9 Whoever is born of God does not commit sin; for <u>His seed remains in him</u>: and he cannot sin, because he is born of God.
- 1 John 4:12 No man has seen God at any time. If we love one another, <u>God dwells in us</u>, and His love is perfected in us.

1 John 4:15-16 (15) Whoever shall confess that Jesus is the Son of God, <u>God dwells in him, and he in God</u>. (16) And we have known and believed the love that God has towards us. God is love; and <u>he</u> who dwells in love <u>dwells in God</u>, and <u>God in him</u>.

He in you

1 John 3:24 And <u>he</u> who keeps his commandments <u>dwells in Him</u>, and <u>He in him</u>. And hereby we know that He remains in us, by the Spirit which He has given us.

1 John 4:4 You are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is <u>He</u> Who is in you, than he who is in the world.

you in God

1 John 4:15-16 (15) Whoever shall confess that Jesus is the Son of God, <u>God dwells in him, and he in God</u>. (16) And we have known and believed the love that God has to us. God is love; and he who dwells in love dwells in God, and God in him.

you in Christ

John 6:56 He who eats My flesh, and drinks My blood, dwells in Me, and I in him.

John 14:20 At that day you shall know that I am in My Father, and you in Me, and I in you.

John 15:4-5 (4) Remain in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it remains in the vine; neither can you, unless you remain in Me. (5) I am the vine, you are the branches: He who remains in Me, and I in him, the same brings forth much fruit: for without Me, you can do nothing.

1 Cor 1:30 By Him <u>you are in Christ Jesus</u>, Who of God is made to us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption:

2 Cor 5:17 Therefore if any <u>man</u> is <u>in Christ</u>, he is a new creature: old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

you in Him

1 John 2:5 But whoever keeps His word, in him certainly is the love of God perfected: hereby we know that we are in Him.

1 John 3:24 And he who keeps His commandments dwells in Him, and He in him. And hereby we know that He remains in us, by the Spirit Whom He has given us.

1 John 4:13 Hereby we know that we dwell in Him, and He in us, because He has given us of His Spirit.

Father in you

Mat 10:20 For it is not you who speaks, but the Spirit of your Father Who speaks in you.

Eph 4:6 One God and Father of all, Who is above all, and through all, and in you all.

Father in Jesus Christ/Jesus Christ in the Father

John 14:9-11 (9) Jesus said to him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; how do you say then, Show us the Father? (10) Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? The words that I speak to you I do not speak of Myself: but the Father, Who dwells in Me, does the works. (11) Believe Me that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me: or else believe Me for the very works' sake.

John 14:13 And I will do whatever you shall ask in My name, that the <u>Father</u> may be <u>glorified in the Son</u>.

John 14:20 At that day you shall know that I am in My Father, and you in Me, and I in you.

John 17:21 That they all may be one; as <u>You, Father, are in Me, and I in You</u>, that <u>they also</u> may be one in Us: that the world may believe that You have sent Me.

John 17:23 <u>I in them, and You in Me</u>, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that You have sent Me, and have loved them, as You have loved Me.

Col 1:19 For it pleased the Father that all fullness should dwell in Him;

God in Jesus Christ

2 Cor 5:19 To wit, that <u>God was in Christ</u>, reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them; and has committed to us the word of reconciliation.

Col 1:19 For it pleased the Father that <u>all fullness should dwell in Him</u>;

Role of the Holy Spirit:

Sometimes we focus solely on the Holy Spirit in us. But He, the Holy Spirit never claimed to be the life—Jesus is the life.

When Christ, Who is our life, shall appear, then you shall also appear with Him in glory. (Col 3:4).

In fact, God puts us in Christ (1 Cor 1:30) so that when He died on the cross, we too died in Him. When He was buried, we were buried in Him. When He rose from the dead, we rose in Him (Romans 6).

By Him you are in Christ Jesus, Who of God is made to us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption: (1 Cor 1:30)

So what is the Holy Spirit doing? He is in our spirits working primarily in our minds so that we know Christ and remember the things of Christ—what He said and did, and guide us to all the truth found in Christ Who is the Way, the Truth, and the Life.

Verbs: **teachs**, **reminds** us of what Christ said, **guides** into truth, **speaks** of Christ, glorifies Christ, **shows** us the things of Christ

John14:26 But the Comforter, Who is the Holy Spirit, Whom the Father will send in My name, shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatever I have said to you.

John 16:13-15 (13) Nevertheless when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth: for <u>He shall not speak of Himself</u>; but whatever He shall hear, that shall He speak: and He will show you things to come. (14) <u>He shall glorify me: for He shall receive of Mine, and shall show it to you.</u> (15) All things that the Father has are Mine: therefore said I, that <u>He shall take of Mine, and shall show it to you</u>.

The Holy Spirit points us to Christ. Even the fruits of the Spirit in Galatians 5 point to Christ, for Christ is the Vine and we are the branches. Christ is the One who bears fruit through the branches (John 15).

The Holy Spirit bears witness of Christ. Christ bears witness of the Father (John 14).
